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### **L** Executive summary

Since the year 1994, Heritage, Culture, Art and Education Development Society is doing the works on the subjects of Education, Health, Empowerment, Gender equity, Environment and such other subjects in Ratnagiri district for Women, children & youth.

The Sanstha is running the secondary high school at Jawade , which is benefitting the poor & needy students in the villages Jawade , Rawari , Isawali , Kante , Bapere etc. The

percentage of leakage of girls students from school is diminished due to this high school. The sanstha has received cooperation of parents in rural area and because of the financial backing of these parents only, the sanstha can run the school successfully.

The sanstha has formed 95 Self Help groups of poor, ignored women and men, under Swarna Jayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana, by entering into contract with District Rural Development Agency, Ratnagiri.



The sanstha is doing the work of forming the Self Help groups, developing the capacity of these SHGs & making available the working capital to these SHGs . Vis-a-vis the sanstha is doing most important work of bringing awareness about social responsibility among the women of these SHGs .The sanstha has made available the working capital of Rs.18,59,000/- to 106 SHGs in Lanja and Rajapur talukas , by regular and continuous follow up . The capacities of the SHGs has been developed by giving them various types of trainings .

## Introduction



'Heritage' sanstha was registered before 12 years. The sanstha has made its own road from very difficult situations in these 12 years. But the cooperation of various persons & organizations has made this way easier. The sanstha has entered into contract with District Rural Development Association, Ratnagiri for forming & running the Self Help Groups under Central Government sponsored Swarna Jayanti Gram Swarojgar Scheme , in the

year 2005 .Thereafter, our sanstha has started forming the SHG from October 2005 .The sanstha has formed Self Help groups in Lanja and Rajapur Talukas after affiliating with District Rural Development Association , Ratnagiri .The sanstha has given stress on empowering the capacities of SHGs after forming the SHGs. The SHGs has enhanced their capacities with the help of various trainings like Basic Concept, capacity building , development of leadership , accounts keeping , participation & control , training of entrepreneurship etc . The businesses of the SHGs has been started and the sanstha has sold the products manufactured by these SHGs through exhibitions .The Sanstha has made efforts to enhance the capacities of the SHGs . The capacity of the sanstha has been developed through various trainings like Panchayat Raj training , Self Help Group training , training of skill development etc. Besides the working of the sanstha has been made systematic due to this .

- Formation of Self Help Groups and their maintenance Formed 74 Self help groups in Lanja, Ratnagiri & Dapoli talukas . Organization of 164 youth & 944 women .
- Construction of groups & Capacity development Parted training of Basic concept, income & Expenditure accounts, accounts and audit, participation, control & entrepreneurship training. Developed the capacities of 122 SHGs.
- Helping groups of poor women

Granted loans from Rs.5000 to Rs.10000 to needy & poor women for their difficulties , for marriage of daughters & construction of toilets etc . from the working capital .

#### **Projection Accomplishment**

- Formation of Self Help group :
- Lanja Formed 53 SHGs . Among them, 39 women , 7 gents & 7 mixed group . In 53 groups , 755 women & 100 gents participated .The working capital of Rs.- 13, 59,000 /- made available to 86 groups . Made available the revolving fund to 86 groups .
- Ratnagiri Formed 15 Self Help Groups in Tonade, Pomendi Budruk, Karwanchiwadi, Someshwar, Panwal, Tembhye, Khedshi, Pomendi Khurd villages. Among them - 7 women groups, 4 gents groups & 5 mixed groups. In these groups, 122 women & 55 gents are there. The monthly contribution to the tune of Rs. 4890 /- is made by them.
- Dapoli Formed 6 groups in Shirde Village. Among them 2 women & 4 mixed groups are there. In 6 groups 67 women and 9 gents are there, who contribute Rs. 1620 /- per month.

#### Loan for business Project

The Saibaba-Kuwe Wareshiwadi group undertaken the business of cashew nut process and made the business of Rs. 35,000 /-.The Bank loan of Rs.2.00 lacs made available to this group.Total subsidy of Rs.1.80 lacs was received by this group.The business of goat farming was started by the Ambhira Veravali Budruk Self Hel Group.The loan of Rs. 2.00 lacs was made available to this group.

#### AIDS Awareness programme for women

150 women and girls of self help groups were participated in this programme . The guidance about AIDS was given & open discussion was made . The awareness was brought among the women & girls. 37 women participated in The programme of Women Health & Til - Gul programme was conducted by Devdhe Self Help group . The Musical chair competition was arranged at this time . 66 women participated in the programme arranged by women of Self Help group. At this time , the musical chair competition was held. In both these programmes, the officers of Primary Health Centre given direction about the health .

#### Awareness programme for Adolescent girls

Participation of 150 girls from the self help groups. The direction was given about the health, cleanliness, social changes, physical & emotional changes, rights & duties etc . The misunderstandings in the minds of the participants was vanished through this programme .
