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Executive Summary



Heritage Sanstha is working on the issues of Health , Empowerment , Capacity Development , Gender Equality, Environment in Ratnagiri District from the year 1974 in Ratnagiri District.

Heritage Sanstha has formed 211 SHG of Women, 55 SHG of men, 35 mix SHG, 3 SHG of Physically handicapped, 7 APL aggregating to 305 SHG and thereby created organization of 673 youth and 2411 women. In last 5 years, the working capital worth Rs.1 Crore has been made available to 300 SHGs. By the Sanstha.

In this year the sanstha has formed new 63 sansthas. Out of them 3 of S.C., 4 SHG s.of Minority Women, 1 SHG of S.T. and 44 SHGs are of the persons belonging to other categories. In the current year the organization of 650 men and women has been created. The sanstha can do the work of forming Self Help groups with the guidance and help of District Rural Development Authority. The organization of more than 60 Scheduled caste youth has been made by the sanstha. In this year the sanstha has undertaken the work of bringing political awareness among the Dalit women and participating them in the Panchayat Raj system.

The Programme of Self development has been undertaken by the Sanstha with the help of the Sanstha Sadhan-Pune and started the process of personality development for the youth. Total 24 cases has been registered with the Sanstha under Domestic Violence Act-2005. Out of them 14 cases were adjusted by counseling, 6 cases are registered in court of law, 4 cases have been awarded and 2 cases are pending. The 30 days training of different business has been given to 55 women and men with the help of Jan Shikshan Sanstha, Sindhudurg.

Introduction

16 years have been passed after registering of the Heritage sanstha. The sanstha has made its own Identity in these 16 years. Till today the sanstha has received guidance & help from various sansthas and persons. The sanstha has been connected to District Rural Development Authority, Ratnagiri from the year 2005. From then till now the sanstha has formed more than 300 Self Help groups.

The sanstha has given stress on formation, maintenance & capacity development of self help groups. The SHGs became self sufficient with the training of Basic concept , Leadership Development, Keeping of Accounts, Participation & control, Awareness of Entrepreneurship & Development. The business of the SHG has been started and the sanstha took initiative to make available the market for the finished goods produced by the SHGs in local market as well as market of Mumbai.

The work of publicizing the features of the Domestic Violence Protection Act-2005 is going on in Lanja & Ratnagiri talukas the work of public awareness is being made for making this act public oriented. The sanstha is making special efforts to give justice to the victim women.

The 30 days training of cashewnut processing, hatchery, mats of coir, and other manufacturing other products is given to 45 women and 10 men with the help of Jan Shikshan Sansthan, Sindhudurg.

The heritage sanstha has started the process of Personality Development for rural women, students, youths with the help of the sanstha Sadhan-Pune. This process will be lasting for one year. Jawade Highschool is selected for this process. The sanstha has started the work of bringing political awareness and government strategies among the Dalit women and make them participate in the Panchayat Raj system.

The work of building of New English School Jawade has been started and this will be completed till June 2010 with the help of villagers.



Undertakings of the Sanstha

□ New English School Jawade , Tal. - Lanja , Dist.- Ratnagiri

The ceremony of Bhoomipujan of New English School, Jawade of the sanstha has been completed by the Industrialist Dilip Baing in the presence of the villagers and guardians. Thereafter the work of construction of the building has been started and in the month of June 2010 the school will be started in the new building. The borewell has been excavated in the property of the sanstha.

□ Formation of Self Help Groups & maintenance Project - Taluka Lanja , Mandangad & Dapoli

New 63 SHGs has been formed in the Lanja Taluka. In this 3 SHGs are of SCs. 4 SHGs of Minority women, 1 SHG of ST, and 44 SHGs are of men and women of other categories. In this year the organization of 650 men and women was made. The working capital of Rs. 7.5 lacs has been made available to 30 SHGs. The Revolving fund of Rs. 3 lacs has been made available to 30 SHGs. The loan of Rs, 20 acs has been made available to 10 SHGs. The subsidy of Rs. 10 lacs has been received by 10 SHGs. The working capital of Rs, 6.50 lacs has been received by 25 SHGs of Ratnagiri Mandangad and Dapoli talukas. The Revolving fund of Rs.2.5 lacs has been made available to the SHGs.

❑ **Basic Training & Training of skill development under SGSY - Tal. - Ratnagiri & Dapoli**



The Training of Basic training , leadership Development, Basic concept and guidance, and skill development was given to the 690 self employed persons below poverty line. The sanstha has undertaken total 50 training through Ratnagiri Panchayat Samiti. The training of basic skill, awareness of skill and skill development to the 234 self employed persons under poverty line was taken in

Dapoli taluka.

❑ **Workshop of Domestic Violence Protection Act - 2005**

The workshop was taken at Lanja on 31st May 2009 for bringing awareness among participants for "Violence free family and violence free society ". In this workshop, the women, sarpanch, Chairmen of Tantamukta Samiti, Police Patil were invited. Participation of 296 persons was made in this workshop. Chandrakant



Manchekar, the Sabhapati of Panchayat Samiti and Police Inspector Sanjiv Ghadge of Lanja Police station had inaugurated this workshop. The guidance was given by Adv.Asunta paradhe of Chetana Mahila Vikas Kendra, Pune. Also the protection officer and Development officer made guidance . The partipants asked various questions regarding the act. Adv.Asunta Paradhe replied their questions

❑ **Training camp for Volunteers**

The Training camp for volunteers was arranged for bringing capacities among volunteers for enhancement of their skill and for acceleration of their work. 13 volunteers were present at this training. The information of various project was given in this training.

□ **Human rights campaign under Domestic Violence Protection Act 2005**

The Human rights week was celebrated on the event of Human Rights day during 9th to 23rd Decemner 2009 in respect of the Domestic Violence Protection Act-2005. Various programmes were conducted at this time. The information about this act was given in the programme conducted in New English School, Jawade, Urmila Mane Vidyalay, Asage, Madhyamik Ashram Shala Kuve-Panhale, Lanja college under Rashtriya Seva Yojana camp. The direction of the law was given to 480 students. The information about this law was given to 210 women of SHGs of Adavali, Agargav, Waked.

□ **Panchayat Raj Awareness Programme for the women of Self Help Group**

The Panchayat Raj Awareness programme was conducted on the event of Anniversary of Savitribai Phule on 3rd January 2010 at Devadhem Tal.Lanja. The inauguration of the programme was made by Panchayat Samiti Member Smita Dalavi. Devaji Harmale, Sarpanch of Devadhe Grampanchayat was the chairman of this programme. The retired Development officer Nathuram Devale gave direction in this programme. 129 women participated this programme.

□ **Self Development Programme**

The sanstha has exploited the programme for the development of rural women, students, youths for personality development . This process will be continuing for one year. Jawade Highschool has been selected for this process. Till today 3 workshop has been started.

□ **Family Counselling & Help centre Lanja and Ratnagiri**

24 cases has been lodged with the sanstha for protection from domestic violence in Lanja and Ratnagiri taluka. 14 cases were adjusted through concnselling 6 cases were registered in the court of law, 4 cases has been awarded and 2 cases are pending

❑ **Training Programme - with the help of Janshikshan Sansthan Sindhudurg**

The 30 days training of cashewnut processing was given to 46 poor women, The training of hatchery, mats of coir and production of other things was given. The training for repairs of domestic appliances was given to 9 youths of Scheduled Caste.

❑ **Organization & Awareness Programme for Dalit youth**

Heritage has formed more than 60 SHGs of Dalit women and youth. The transactions for these SHGs are going on smoothly. The organization of the women and youth has been made by the sanstha through these SHGs. The sanstha has started the work of organization of bringing awareness political among women and make them participate in the Panchayat Raj System. In the first phase the work of bringing awareness among them is handled.

❑ **Workshops, Trainings, Participation in the state level meetings**

The Sanstha chief Santosh Kambale, Project coordinator Nutan Kadam participated in the 3 days workshop taken by Yashada, Pune. They also took active participation in the Development workshop on the subject of Domestic Violence Protection Act 2005 .



Achievement of the Sanstha -

● **New English School Jawade ,Tal.Lanja, Dist. Ratnagiri.**

The education of 80 girls upto 10th standard. The result of the school 92 %. More than 160 students passed in 10th standard. The students & guardians are satisfied as the work of construction of building of Jawade Highschool is started.

● **The Formation of Self Help Groups and their maintenance- Tal.Lanja, Mandangad, Dapoli, Ratnagiri**

Lanja - The organization of 650 men and women has been made because of formation of 63 new Self Help Groups. The working capital of Rs. 1607400 has been received and the Revolving funds (Subsidy) of Rs. 740000 has been made available.

● **Ratnagiri and Dapoli** -The working capital of Rs. 275000/- has been made available to 11 SHGs. And Revolving funds of Rs. 110000 is made available.

- **Basic training & Skill Development Training under SGSY Taluka - Ratnagiri & Dapoli**



The development of the 1000 poor men and women has been achieved due to the trainings of Basic training, leadership development, skill development programme, and basic training for starting different businesses. The poor women and men has started their own businesses. The capacity of the self employed persons has been enhanced due to the training of skill development and basic concept.

- **Domestic Violence Protection Act-2005 workshop**

The awareness was brought among the women of SHGs, Sarpancha, Police patil, President of Tantamukta Samiti. The direction was received as to how the justice can be given to the deserving victim women.

- **Training camp for volunteers**

The work of the volunteers of the sanstha has been accelerated due to the skill developed through the training. The benefit of this training was received by 13 volunteers. The information about the working of banks, government offices was received through these trainings.



- **Panchayat Raj Awareness programme for the women of SHGs:**

The information about the working of Sthanik Swaraj Sanstha was made known to women of Self Help Groups. The awareness about their rights was made. The information about the opportunities in Panchayat Raj was received by the women.

- **Self Development programme :**

The Sanstha has started the development process with the help of Sadhan Pune for the development of Women, students, youths. Till now 3 work shops has been completed under this process.

- **Human rights Week under Domestic Violence Protectiono Act 2005 campaign :**

The awareness was brought among the school & college going students about the Domestic violence protection act 2005 in the camp of Rashtriya Seva Yojana held during the period from 9th to 23rd Decemer 2009 in the New English School Jawade , Urmia Mane Vidyalaya Asage , Madhyamik Ashram Shala Kuve - Panhale , on



the event of Human Rights day . Aso he awareness about this act was brought among the women members of the Self Help Groups in he villages Adavali , Agargav , Waked .

- **Family Counselling and Help Centre, Lanja and Ratnagiri**

The 24 cases were registered in the Sanstha in Lanja & Ratnagiri talukas under Dmestic Violence Protection Act-2005 . 14 cases were adjusted by counseling , 10 cases were registered with court of law , award was given in case of 9 cases .



- **Training programme with the collaboration of Janshikshan Samnsta Sanstha Sindhudurg**

The 30 days training of cashewnut processing was given to 46 poor women , The training of hatchery , mats of coir and production of other things was given . The training for repairs of domestic appliance s was given to 9 touths of Scheduled Caste .

- **Organization of Dalit youth and awareness programme**

Heritage has formed more than 60 SHGs of Dalit women and youth The sanstha has started the work of organization and bringing political awareness among and and make them participate in the Panchayat Raj System . The the view was brought among the youth .

- **Workshops, Trainings, Participation in the state level meetings**

The realization of working was made due to the 3 days workshop taken by Yashada Pune . The active participation was taken in the Development workshop and hence the vision document of the sanstha was prepared .

 **Results achieved / Significant Achievement**

- 9 cases disposed under Domestic Violence Protection Act-2005.
- Disbursement of loan to women for construction of WC and for marriage of daughter.
- 30 % students have completed education upto degree, 5 students started small businesses.
- Disbursement of loan of Rs.50 lacs to 50 Self help groups. Subsidy received of Rs.25 lacs. Business of 20 SHGs started.
- Formation of organizations of 1000 youth and 5000 women through Self help groups.
- Made available Rs.1 Corer to Self help groups.
- Developed the capacities of 1000 Self employed persons in Ratnagiri & Dapoli talukas.

Constraints / Difficulties faced

- The victim women does not dare to come forward.
- Delay in sanctioning loans to Self Help groups by the bank.
- Frequent obstacles in the work due to disputes and groupism.
- Lack of business mentality .
- Impact of traditional farming, therefore neutral view to start new business.
- Delay by the government in receiving the subsidy.

Lessons learnt

- The entire concept of the subject or the project should be given to the public by gathering them.
- The works adopted should be complied with well in prescribed time.
- The concerned should be made known their works & responsibilities clearly.
- Alertness & transparency in the work is must for the reliance of the public.

Future Plans

- To start skill training for women, children and youth.
- Starting Family Counseling & Help centre at Dapoli, Pachal and Mandangad.
- Making available market for the finished goods produced by the Self help groups.
- Giving stress on capacity development of self help groups.
- Forming individual structure for sale of the finished products produced.
- Exploiting various programmes like Panchayat Raj, Dalit awareness Programme, Programmes for Livelihood.
