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Executive Summary

The institution is engaged in the activities of Self Help Groups since the year 2005. The Sanstha has established more than 400 SHG's in Ratnagiri, Rajapur, Dapoli, Mandangad & Lanja Talukas under Swarna Jayanti Gram Swarojgar Scheme. The sanstha has formed unity of 1000 young boys and 4000 women. The sanstha has made available Rs. 1.5 Crores to 400 SHG's for conducting different business and to cater their financial needs in lat 6 years.

In Lanja Taluka, 8 new SHG's has been established in this year. 50 SHG's has received Rs.12,50,000 working capital, whereas the Revolving Fund (Subsidy) opf Rs.5 lakhs has been received by them. The loan of Rs.46 lacs is made available to 23 SHG's. These SHG's has received subsidy of Rs.21,40,000/-. The sanstha has received co-operation from District Rural Development Authority, Ratnagiri, all the Panchayat Samiti & Grampanchayats.

The Sanstha has established unity of youths of Backward Class community and created 100 SHG's of Backward Class youths . Heritage has made efforts to empower these SHG's."Heritage"is doing the work of bringing the political awareness among the Backward Class Women and youth, for increasing their participation in the Panchayat Raj management.

The campaign of Awareness programme about the Domestic Violence Act 2005, is being conducted in 10 villages; thereby the awareness about this act has been brought in the women of these 10 villages. The 40 cases has been registered with the Sanstha under this act in Lanja and Ratnagiri talukas. Out of them, 21 cases has been solved with the help of counseling. 19 cases has been lodged in the Court and 12 of them has been awarded the orders by court. 07cases are pending.

The sanstha is having the land admeasuring 3 acres (Survey No.Gat No.802 A-2) at Jawade, Tal.Lanja. The market value of this land is Rs.10,20,000/-. The market value of the secondary school namely New English School Jawade of the sanstha is Rs. 15,00,000/- Separate toilet blocks are constructed for boys & girls in this school.

The sanstha has parted the basic training & skill development training to the 588 beneficiaries below poverty line in Ratnagiri & Dapoli talukas, under Swarna Jayanti Gram Swarojgar Scheme .

The SHG's namely Dnyaneshwari - Veravali Khurd, Mata Ramai - Kurne, Disha - Asode, established by our sanstha has won the Rajmata Jijau Self Help Award & the District Level Third Price of Village Development Department of Maharashtra Government for the year 2010 has been won by SHG's Nakshatra, Panhale, established by our sanstha.

The senior officers Shri David Kadam and Smt. Gurjit of the Funding Agency "Swiss Aid " visited the villages in the work field of the sanstha. They have admired the

working strategy of the sanstha & the work of the women empowerment done by the members of the sanstha.

The Sanstha has received 12-A & 80-G Certificate from Hon. Income Tax Commissioner, Kolhapur.

Introduction

Our institution "Heritage, Culture Art and Education Development Society" has been registered before 16 years. This is the 17th years of the Sanstha. In these 16 years, the sanstha has created a goodwill and identification. The sanstha has received cooperation of various persons, organizations, establishments and government associations & offices.

The sanstha has won the award from District Publity officer of Eradication of Addiction of Maharashtra Government for doing the best work of getting rid of addiction. The members of the sanstha Aparna Pawar, Sandip Kamble, Chandrakant Kamble, Founder member Santosh Kamble has received the certificate for this work.

The sanstha has received the certificate from Panchayat Samiti Lanja for doing the best work of forming SHG's of the persons below poverty line, under the Central Government sponsored Swarna Jayanti Gram Swarojgar Scheme . The Founder Santosh Kambale has won the Rajmata Jijau Self Help Award for the year 2008 from Village Development Department of Maharashtra Government for his work of journalism for overall development, by giving sizeable publicity to the difficulties and obstacles of the financial, social, political and health related problems of SHG's.

The sanstha is in touch of District Rural Development Authority from the year 2005. The sanstha has established more than 400 SHG's of persons below poverty line. All these SHG's are saving about Rs.70,000/- per month in various banks. The annual turnover of all these SHG's is around Rs.25 lakhs.

The sanstha has given various trainings like Basic Concept (2 days), Leadership development, keeping income-expenditure accounts & keeping meeting book and minutes books, financial decision and evaluation (1 day each), entrepreneurship awareness training (2 days), Industrialist development training (2-3 days), for capacity building and skill development of SHG's. The sanstha has given training to 4000 women. Besides, the sanstha has given the trainings of health of girls and women, cleanliness, keeping of environment, adult education, legal rights of women, Protection of women from Domestic Violence Act 2005 and other social aspects. The activities of SHG's has been started & the sanstha has taken initiative to make available the market of Mumbai , Kolhapur , Pune including local market for the goods produced by these SHG's.

The sanstha has started the movement of SHG's in Lanja Taluka. These SHG's has achieved progress due to the direction of the sanstha. Due to such type of direction,

the Saibaba SHG's of Kuve Wareshiwadi has won the Taluka Level Rajmata Jijau Award - 2007.

The campaign of bringing awareness about the Women's Protection from Domestic Violence Act-2005 has been running by the sanstha since last two years in the 10 villages namely Gavane, Devadhe, Manachegaon, Buddhwai Tarfe Devadhe, Adavali, Khavadi, Veravali Khurd, Upale, Veergaon and Vaked of Lanja Taluka.

The sanstha has formed 5 Adhargat of men and 5 Adhargat of women in 10 villages. The sanstha has given direction to nearly 1000 women in 10 villages. The sanstha is doing efforts especially for giving justice to the victim women with the help of this act.

The sanstha has started the work of bringing awareness about politics & government strategies among the youth and women, so as to participate them in the Panchayat Raj Management.

The work of construction of building of Jawade High school has been completed. The cooperation of head of institution Shri Santosh Kambale and guardians of student has been received for this. Till today, about 200 students has taken their education.

Programme Goal

Empowerment of Ruined, poor and ignored women, youth and children.

Programme objective

- 1. Making development of Ruined, poor and ignored women & youth in Rural area.
- 2. Making social and political empowerment of poor, ignored women,
- 3. Making poor, ignored youth, women and farmers financially and socially strong.
- 4. Bringing awareness about the law among the member women of SHG's .
- 5. Inspiring the men to take a role to understand women .
- 6. Giving industrial view to rural youth and women .

Activities of Sanstha

New English School , Jawade , Tal. Lanja , Dist . Ratnagiri

The dream of Institution head Santosh Kambale to erect own building of Jawade High School turned into truth, due to the co-operation of villagers and donors. The sizeable amount of Rs.12 lakh was spent for constructing the specious school building of six classrooms. The residents of the villages Katalgaon, Jawade, Rawari, Isavali-Patharwadi paid contribution of Rs.251/- each. The Mumbai residents of these villages also gave their financial contribution. The local board of directors

gave their help for funds collection under the guidance of Founder promoters. On the auspicious Indian Republic day, the students entered the new building of school.

• Formation and maintenance of Self Help Groups

New 8 SHG's are formed in Lanja Taluka. Out of them 01 SHG is of Scheduled Caste, 074 SHGs are of minority women, 01 SHG is of Scheduled tribes and 02 SHGs are of men-women of other category. Under the said scheme, the working capital of Rs.12,50,000/- was made available to 50 SHGs. The Revolving fund of Rs.5.00 lakhs was made available to 50 SHG's. The sanstha made available the loan of Rs.46 lakhs to 23 SHG's. The 23 SHG's received the subsidy of Rs.21,40,000/- .

Basic training and skill development training under SGSY-Ratnagiri & Lanja

The sanstha gave Basic traning, fundamental guidance & Skill Development training to 340 self employed persons below poverty line under Swarna Jayanti Gram Swarojgar Scheme was given. The sanstha undertook total 21 trainings through Ratnagiri Panchayat Samiti. The sanstha gave skill development trainings to 248 self employed persons in Dapoli taluka.

Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act , 2005

For bringing awareness among men about Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 & tending them to take a role towards women, the training of male members was held during the period from 12 to 13.05.2010 at Lanja. In this training programme, Sanjay Lokhande - secretary of Kokan Vikas Samanvay Vyaspeeth, Adv.Samiksha Parulekar, Shubhangi Kolage made a direction. In the said training, 40 men participated including Sarpanch from 10 villages, Vice Sarpanch and Members of Tantamukta Samiti . At the same time, the training of women was held , in which 105 women from 10 villages were participated. The awareness about Domestic Violence was made. The basic concept of Adhargat was made clear to them. The guidance was given for forming strongly such Adhargat in their villages for giving helping hand to the victim women.

Public Awareness Rally for Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005

For creation of "Violence-free family and Violence-free society" and for publicity of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act,2005, the Cycle and Public Awareness Rally was held in Lanja city from Chavhata mandir to Tehsil Office on 27.07.2010. In this rally, MLA Rajan Salavi, Block Development Officer M.M.Jadhav and other renowned office bearers & officers were participated. The pedestrians and cycle rider were giving agitations for 25 minutes in this rally through the market area. Thereafter this rally arrived at Tehsil office and it converted into a meeting. In this meeting, MLA Rajan Salvi, Block Development officer M.M.Jadhav addressed their speech to public about Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act,2005. 77 persons participated in this rally.

Public Awareness Campaign for Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005

In the Public Awareness Campaign for Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, 120 awareness meetings were taken in the villages Gawane, Devadhe, Manachegaon, Budhwadi Tarfe Devadhe, Adavali, Khavadi, Veravali Khurd, Upale, Veergaon, Waked in Lanja Taluka in this year. 1300 women were participated in these meetings. The training about law was given to 10 women Adhargat and 5 Men Adhargat in ten villages. The guidance about the law was given to 1000 women in 10 villages. The guidance about the law was given to 80 students of Lanja Senior College in the camp at Ravari arranged under Rashtriya Seva Yojana.

Awareness of Panchayat Raj Programme for women of Self Help Groups

The Panchayat Raj Awareness programme was held at Jawade, Tal.Lanja on the event of Anniversary of Savitribai Phule on 3rd january 2010, so as to make the members of SHG's familiar about the working of Sthanik Swaraj Sanstha. 129 women were present for this programme. The guidance on various subject was given to the participant women on the subjects like Amendment of 73rd and 74th provision of constitution, 33% reservation for women in Sthanik Swaraj Sanstha, Special Village meeting, Women and Child Welfare Fund, the duties and right of Woman Sarpanch, active participation of women in Panchayat Raj, opportunities for women public representatives in the politics etc.

D Family Consultation and Assistance Centre - Lanja and Ratnagiri

The preference is being given for counseling, when any case is entered in the Sanstha under Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005. The efforts are being made to solve it by mutual understanding. Total 33 cases were registered with the Sanstha in Lanja and Ratnagiri. Out of them, 17 cases were solved with counseling. 16 cases were lodged in the court of law, out of which, 4 cases were solved. 12 cases are still pending.

Awareness programme for Census of Backward Class community

The financial, social & political losses were made to people of Navboudha community, as the Nav Boudh community was barred from the Schedule Caste Cadre in the census of 2001. Consequently the population of Nav Boudha community was registered at lesser side. Therefore, the persons of Nav Boudha Community are deprived from the political reservation. The sanstha srated the campaign for this before starting the census of 2011. The information about the reservation and law of census was given in this campaign. The guidance was given to the public as to what information should be given to the census Representative (Praganak). This campaign was exploited in Lanja, Rajapur, Ratnagiri talukas in the months of April, & May. 40000 handbills were distributed. The volunteers of Sanstha impressed the importance of this campaign to the concerned by visiting the Wadies of backward class areas.

Youth Welfare Programme in Rural area - Arrangement of Self Employment Camp

The Self employment camp was arranged at Jawade for giving training of Cashewnut process to the girls and women & inspiring them for self employent. The inauguration of this training camp was made by Shri Uday Bane, the Vice President of Zilla Parishad. In this camp, the guidance was given to the participants. Cashew nut process, Marketing Management & technique of acquiring market, preparation of project report, PRA Technology for sell, agricultural schemes & self employment. 90 youth & girls participated in this camp.

Participation in Workshop , training programmes, state level meetings

The Organization head Santosh Kambale, Organizer Nutan Kadam & Regional worker Darshana Chavan participated in the state level and regional workshop under Centre for Leadership programme of CORO, Mumbai. They also took active participation in the Divisional workshop and training programme of Domestic Violence Act 2005 undertaken by Chetana Vikas Kendra, Pune. They took initiative for arrangement of Divisional Public hearing held for DV Act 2005 at Ratnagiri on 02.05.2010. Besides, the volunteers of the sanstha participated the Food Right Workshop, Save Daughter campaign, the programme of Vikas Sahayog Pratishthan, Mumbai. Also the volunteers took part in programmes of Asha Yojana, Ex-Adivasi Taluka Trainer Training, Formation of SHG's, Development and Bank Linkages training programmes, arranged by NABARD and SOSWA Pune (STAPI)

Sanstha Anniversary Day

The programme of tree plantation held on 26.07.2010 in the property of the Sanstha at Jawade on the occasion of 16th Anniversary of the sanstha. The plants of Teak, Vad etc. were planted. On this event, the students, teachers and workers of the sanstha took oath to flourish the trees and protect the environment. In this programme, the villagers took participation.

Achievement of Sanstha

New English School Jawade , Tal. Lanja , Dist . Ratnagiri

The Jawade High school run by the sanstha grabbed a result of 97 percent in the SSC Examination of March 2010. Out of 27 students, only one girl failed and all the rest students passed. The High School has maintained upcoming trend of result right from the approval of government. Till now, 160 students have passed successfully the 10th standard. The students and their parents / guardians were delighted on completion of school building.

• Formation and Maintenance of Self Help Group :

The unity of 76 persons was made possible due to formation of 8 new SHG's in Lanja Taluka. The 50 groups received the working capital of Rs.12.50 lakhs and Revolving fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs. The loan of 46 lakhs was sanctioned to 23 groups.

The subsidy of Rs.21,40,000/- was received by them. 23 groups have started various businesses.

Basic and Skill Development Training programme under SGSY-Taluka Ratnagiri & Dapoli

Since the Basic and Skill Development Training programme under SGSY has been given to 588 men-women self employed persons in Ratnagiri and Dapoli talukas, they could start their own business. These 588 self employed persons could develop their capacity skill.

Training of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act , 2005

Due to the training of this Act was taken for gents, they brought awareness about Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act,2005 among them. The basic concept of Adhar gat was made known to them and the strong background was created among them to build the Adhargat in the village for giving help to victim women. The guidance was given about how the victim women could give justice.

Public Awareness Rally for Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005

The sanstha could succeed in attracting attention of public due to arrangement of Public Awareness Rally and cycle rally for Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act,2005 in the Lanja city. Due to this rally, the awareness about this law was brought among the officers, public representatives, workers and youth.

Panchayat Raj Awareness programme for Self Help Group member women

Due to this programme, the women members got information of Panchayat Raj working, they realized their rights. They obtained the knowledge of opportunities available in Sthanik Swaraj Sanstha and about the reservation of women. These women came to know as to what qualities are essential for making leadership.

Public Awareness Campaign for Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005

The students were made aware about the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act,2005, as the information about this act was given in Lanja College in the camp arranged under Rashtriya Seva Yojana (National Service Scheme). 1000 women from the villages of Gawane, Devadhe, Manachegaon, Budhwadi Tarfe Devadhe, Adavali, Upale, Veergaon, Waked, Veravali Khurd, Khawadi get knowledge of this act. The sanstha also made efforts to make the men from 10 villages aware and sensational about the domestic violence made on women. The awareness about this act was brought among the men.

D Family Consultation and Assistance Centre - Lanja and Ratnagiri

Total 40 cases were registered with the Sanstha in Lanja and Ratnagiri talukas. Out of them, 21 cases were solved with counseling. 7 cases were lodged in the court of law, out of which, 12 cases were solved .

Awareness programme for Census of Backward Class community

The study of Census Act and strategies about the Backward class community was made. Proper role was taken for inclusion of Nav Boudha community. The social participation of public was extended. The awareness was bought among the persons of Nav Boudha Community for inclusion of Boudh Community in Scheduled Caste category. In this campaign, the volunteers of sanstha visited 200 Boudhwadis.

Youth Welfare Programme in Rural area - Arrangement of Self Employment Camp

The training of Cashew nut processing was given to girls and women and thus the mentality of the women &girls was created for making business. They got information about Marketing management, &technique of acquiring market, preparation of project report, PRA Technology for sell. They were given guidance about agricultural schemes and self employment. 90 youth & girls made aware about self employment.

D Participation in Workshop, training programmes, state level meetings

Due to the state level and regional workshop under Centre for Leadership programme of CORO Mumbai, the workers could get knowledge about personality development & capacity development. The knowledge about the Domestic Violence Act 2005 was received divisional training programme undertaken by Chetana Vikas Kendra, Pune. The workers of the sanstha got experience of this big programme due to the initiative for arrangement of Divisional Public hearing held for DV Act, 2005 at Ratnagiri. Besides , the volunteers of the sanstha participated the Food Right Workshop,Save Daughter campaign programme of VSP, Mumbai. Also the volunteers took part in programmes of Asha Yojana , Ex-Adivasi Taluka Trainer Training, Formation of SHG's, Development & Bank Linkages training programmes, arranged by NABARD & SOSWA Pune (STAPI), which helped them to develop their ability & skills.

This 3 acres land has been transferred in the name of Trust Fund. The market value of the Sanstha owned Jawade High School building comprising of six rooms is Rs.15,00,000/-.

- Skill Development Training given to 588 Self Employed persons in Ratnagiri & Dapopli Talukas , Training of self employment to 90 youth & girls

Constraints / Difficulties faced

The victim women hesitate to come forward , Delay in sanctioning the loan proposals of SHGs ., Frequent Obstacles in working due to internal disputes and groupism , Non mentality of entrepreneurship, impact of traditional agriculture, neutral about the business. , Delay for receiving subsidy from government

Lessons Learnt

- The entire concept of the subject and project must be given to participants.
- Continuous efforts must be taken for changing the mass mentality
- The volunteers should complete their works within stipulated time while changing themselves. More transparency must create in working for trustworthiness and must be careful.
